## BACKGROUND

The word tribal carries with it the message of rustic simplicity of environmental consciousness & living in harmony with nature & liberty. Tribals in India are one of the most marginalised communities with little to no access to basic necessities of life like healthcare; education; livelihood opportunities. With the gradual destruction of natural resources especially forests which traditionally sustain these indigenous cultures they have to adjust to the outside cultural; social and economic forces for their survival. The indigenous and traditional cultures of the various tribal populations is being eroded and replaced by an outside economic force and this growth centred model results in an increase in social injustice and environmental degradation. But a people centred model envisages the sustainable development of local resources to meet the needs of the people living in the area and thereby improve their quality of life. This approach ensures the strengthening of local control over resources; broaden participation; ownership and management of local resources in order to promote diversified and self reliant rural economies.

INRECA Sansthan is an action oriented rural development & institute working in 100% tribal areas of Bharuch and Narmada districts of Gujarat state since 1984 without any discrimination based on caste, creed & community. 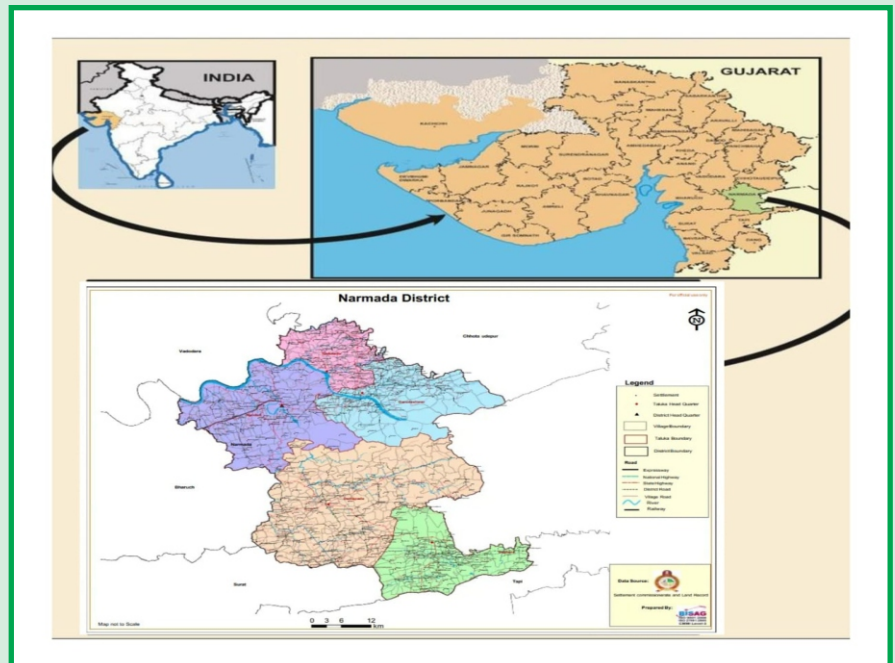

Establishing dispensaries, maternity homes and child welfare centers. Assisting weaker section of society and to construct their own house. 1 Developing minor and community irrigation schemes. 1 Supplying agricultural inputs such as fertilizers, insecticides and plant equipment to tribals. Generate employment opportunities. Development rural industries and management systems including establishment of cooperatives. Develop drinking water resources through installation of hand pumps, construction and maintenance of open wells. t Establish Vocational Training Centre and conduction of workshop seminars, training courses etc for education and skills development 1 Conduct research activities in social and technical subject relevant to rural development. Establish cooperative societies for organizing and managing community resources, value addition through processing, marketing etc.

## GEOGRAPHICAL COVERAGE

Narmada was carved out as a district in 1997 with four talukas. Currently Narmada has five. talukas Dediapada: Sagbara; Nandod; Garudeshwar and Tilakwada. STRICT INRECA has been working in the Five talukas Namely Dediapada, Sagbara Nandod Garudeshwar & Tilakwada of Narmada District and Two talukas of Bharuch District.

## VISION

To under take process documentation as a social science research methodology for collectivization of ideas, enabling participation at different levels, building people's capabilities and enabling people to take responsibilities. To promote social harmony and respect for different cultures, heritage, religions and customs.



INRECA has been working in the Five talukas Namely Dediapada, Sagbara Nandod Garudeshwar & Tilakwada of Narmada District and Two talukas of Bharuch District.

## SANITATION

Department of Rural Development, Government of India Swachh Bharat Abhiyan campaign on 2 October 2014, aims to eradicate open defecation by 2 October 2019, the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. INRECA Sansthan has played a very vital role since its inception through various schemes like the Central Rural Sanitation Programme (CRSP); Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC) and others. Under these schemes INRECA has constructed low cost latrines in Dediapada, Sagbara blocks of Narmada district; Ankleshwar block of Bharuch District, Dhrol block of Jamnagar district of Gujarat and Dadra & Nagar Haveli (UT). This rural sanitation programme was initiated in 1987 and has till date has constructed about 10,000 low cost toilets in individual houses so far.

## SOCIAL FORESTRY AND AFFORESTATION PROGRAMME INRECA

INRECA Sansthan has been involved in social forestry and afforestation programme since 1985 through the promotion of group nurseries, farmers' nurseries, institutional nurseries and decentralized people's nurseries in order to promote afforestation of wastelands, degraded

forest lands as well as planting trees on bunds in agricultural lands owned by the farmers themselves. Bunding plantation work was carried out in 20 villages covering 300 hectares of land and about 5000 plants were planted on bunding sides in the operational areas of INRECA Sansthan Community Irrigation Co-operative INRECA is bringing saplings from the forest department and planting in the complex, near INRECA Sansthan had been appointed as the district nodal agency for Narmada District for constructing individual sanitary units in Narmada district by Department of Rural Development, Government of Gujarat. Gujarat State Water Supply & Sewage Board, Gandhinagar has also assigned the task for construction of Block Toilet Complex in government run Primary and Secondary schools in Narmada District, INRECA has constructed 5 Block Sanitation for students and one Pay and Use Block at Dediapada bus stand. More over about 1000 low cost house under Indira Awas Yojana (IAY) and Sardar Awas Yojana (SAY) are constructed with toilets.

About 500 houses constructed in 20 resettlement colonies of Dediapada, Narmada dam oustees anywhere in Narmada. Society Ltd and as a result more than 2000 plants have been planted in Dediapada block while about 2500 plants have been planted in 22 villages of Dhrol block of Jamnagar district. INRECA Sansthan got approval of social forestry and afforestation programme under degraded forest land in the vicinity of tribal villages of Dediapada block. Under the watershed development programme, INRECA had raised nurseries in 3 villages and plantation work was carried out in these villages with about 100000 plants grown under this project. Despite the discontinuation of afforestation activities due to non availability of funds school buildings, etc.

## AGRICULTURE

Multi-disciplinary Action in Agricultural Production (MAAP) was a pilot scheme that was launched in 2016-17 with the objective to provide irrigational facilities to small and marginal farmers of tribal community through digging of deep bore wells, electrification, installation of submersible motors and pipelines in order to fulfill the basic requirement of the irrigation scheme. Moreover some other allied activities like supplying of seed kits, fertilizers, insecticides, pesticides, agricultural tools on subsidy basis as well as field services were also envisaged in order to get all the services at one point.

## LAND DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

INRECA Sansthan has been involved in land development activities keeping in mind the local topographic situation. Land leveling work; contour bunding; terracing; plantation

## CONSTRUCTION OF CHECK DAMS

INRECA Sansthan is involved in the construction of small check dams on the small rivulets in about 25 villages

with diverse objectives like minor irrigation; water conservation; soil conservation; recharging of

## CONSTRUCTION OF BIOGAS PLANTS

INRECA has constructed about 200 biogas plants in Dediapada block of Bharuch district. The main ration able for taking up this Programme was to promote renewable sources of energy and using biogas waste as organic manure, maximizing utilization of cow dung (gobar) available in the tribal areas and reducing deforestation due to use of firewood and thereby promote environment INRECA Sansthan tried to personalize the scheme in a big way and got tremendous success in the previous year and in the current year as well by irrigating 250 acres of land in 10 villages of Dediapada block. Assets under the MAAP have been transferred to the registered cooperative (INRECA Sansthan Community Irrigation Cooperative Society Ltd). This cooperative society continues to render services to their own beneficiaries by providing irrigation water, supervision,

marketing of products, supplying of seeds, fertilizers, insecticides as well as agricultural tools on subsidized basis. work has been carried out to absorb the rain water and check the erosion of fertile top soil as well as maximize the use of barren lands. ground water. Local people use this water for washing, bathing and drinking as well as for cattle care to quench their thirst.. conservation. In addition the social implications of the effect on health due to reduction of smoke in the cooking area, reduction of soot deposit on utensils and increased convenience were other reason, which promoted INRECA to take up this activity.

## Narmada Hospital & Research Centre (NHRC) (10 or More Bedded Hospital)

INRECA Sansthan is engaged in health awareness and SBCC activities since last 21 years. Last previous 3 years, we had realized to start OPD hospital with some few beds at our existing premises so that health services could be imparted to the local tribal community. Truly demand is on higher side but due to financial constraints facing a lot of problems in rendering services properly. So, we decided to approach to Ministry of Tribal Affairs, New Delhi under GIA scheme which has been duly considered our request under 10 or more bedded Hospital Scheme by Ministry of Tribal Affairs, New Delhi Future Plan for expending hospital in full-fledged manner by seeking loan from Nationalized bank and develop a SUPER SPECIALITY HOSPITAL named NARMADA HOSPITAL & RESEARCH CENTRE (NHRC) in order to provide quality medical facilities in remote and tribal area. gynec, pediatric, General Surgery. Orthopedic department & other Facilities Shall be initiated along with our lab. X ray, OT, Pharmasict Facilities shall be available in ending year 2022-23. In the wake COVID19 pandemic, Protocol we Continued to care & Medicare to the Patients who coming across the boundaries of Dadiapada & Sagbara Blocks. Total-18346 patients are treated, diagnosed & Counseled during the year-2024-25. The details are given as under:

## VANDANA NURSING & PARA MEDICAL COLLEGE

Working with tribal community in this Narmada valley since last about 4 decades , we have come to this unflinching conviction that Tribal girls are more sturdy, workaholic and sincere if they are offered opportunities vocationalise or impart training to them so undoubtedly ; the economic scenario will invariably improve. INRECA Sansthan decided to run nursing college in this remote tribal area so that tribal students may undergo training at local level and can stand on their own feet especially girls. So, INRECA Sansthan constructed a building of about 45000 sq ft and ANM/ GNM courses has initiated by last Academic year 2024-25 for 2 years & 3 years duration courses respectively. Government of Gujarat has allotted 40 seats each course initially. It has come in the notice our district administration also that our tribal girls are exploited in terms of monetary as well as other ways when they opting to go outside to pursue their courses out of state. In order to avoid such instances and misbehavior forced to launch these courses immediately and hopefully BSc (Nursing), PB BSc (Nursing) shall also be started in next couple of years. Preparations are on the way to launch other Para Medical courses like Pharmacist, Sanitary Inspector and Technicians for X rays, Dialysis, OT as well as Diagnostic etc.



# VANDANA DIAGNOSTIC CENTRE



### CREDIT AND THRIFT ACTIVITY

INRECA Sansthan has been involved in Micro credit finance for the tribal beneficiaries and provides an access to credit to them through various cooperative societies. Loans were made available to the beneficiaries to the tune of 40 lakhs since 1985. The amount of loan disbursed in the year 2017-18 was -20 lakhs. The loans are provided through National and regional rural banks and even INRECA's own funds. The recovery of the loans has been 100%. At present INRECA Sansthan is associated with 80 odd SHGs in 65 villages of Dediapada block and 30 SHGs in 30 villages of Sagbara blocks. The total membership stands at 2000. Some groups are also being formed in Dadra & Nagar Haveli (UT).

#### Objectives of the SHGs:

- To create awareness among the women for saving for future
- To make them habitual for compulsory savings
- To organize the saving of groups as their own
- To provide loan to the needy members of groups
- To sure the return of loan by themselves
- To exact the mutual understanding and responsibility in order to uplift themselves

INRECA is working with MISSION MANGAL AMPROJECT launched by Government of Gujarat whose main objective is to initiate economic emancipation through utilizing the SHGs as a tool in form of SAKHI MANDALS who are engaged in credit & thrift under micro-finance pattern. More than 25 groups have been formed under the SGSY in both Dediapada and Sagbara blocks of Narmada district. Under the Gokul Gram Yojana out of the total 698 villages of Narmada district 15 villages are supposed to be covered under SGSY so that they may be provided finance to their Individual or group activities in order to enhance their socio-economic status.

### AWARENESS GENERATION PROGRAMME FOR WOMEN

Central Social Welfare Board has launched a ambitious plan to aware the women, particularly of schedule cast tribes in all respect in order to aware them about their rights. Secondly, Panchayati Raj, a crucial subject to today where maximum emphasis has been given to decentralized the power particularly women are constituting about 50% reservation to empower them. Thirdly, maximum benefits! results should come, polio pulse, Measles, immunization, Menstrual health and

hygiene, Discard early agemarriages, etc, and this is only possible when women would be aware about these benevolent schemes.

# LIVELIHOOD ACTIVITIES

## Executive Summary

The Livelihood Program for the financial year 2024–25, implemented under the partnership between INRECA and Reliance Foundation, focused on improving the self-reliance and resilience of rural communities across the Narmada District. Key interventions centered around climate-resilient agriculture, sustainable water management, women's entrepreneurship, and institutional strengthening. This report summarizes major achievements, outreach data, and the positive impact created through convergence with government schemes and active community participation.

**Livelihood Project Name:-** Improving the Self Reliance and Resilience of the rural communities of the Narmada District partnership project Reliance Foundation

## Theme:-1 Climate Resilience for Sustainable Development (CR4SD)

**Mass awareness Program:-** GPDP Awareness Program: 24 villages Conducted at the village level, these sessions aimed to involve communities comprehensively in the participatory planning process. Gram Panchayats played a crucial role in the effective and efficient implementation of the plan participated- 702. World Environment Day Celebration: Celebrated in 16 villages with the planting of 690 saplings. A total of 453 men and women participated in the event.

**Hands-on Training and Participatory Exercises with the Community:** A Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) exercise was conducted in 85 villages to identify common resources and village issues. This process enabled us to gather crucial information through community engagement. As part of the exercise, two types of village maps were created: 1. Social Map – To understand the village layout and social infrastructure. 2 Resource Map – To assess the availability and utilization of natural resources. Total Participate-1524.

**Additional water harvesting capacity created:-** Renovation of Water Harvesting Structures In 15 villages, existing water harvesting structures were identified for repair through community participation and the Village Development Committee (VDC). These structures were renovated, enabling the harvesting of 779183 CUM of water.

**Efficient water technique:-** Narmada is the hilly area and water scarcity, farmers are facing in Rabi, ground water is depletion day today, our objective is mobilization among the communities efficient water technology, we have promote to Rain Pipe irrigation system which is to promote efficient water use in agriculture, the Rain Pipe Irrigation System has been introduced in 41 selected villages. This lowcost, easy-to-install system helps farmers irrigate their fields more effectively, especially in areas with limited water availability. This technique through 300 hector are covered.

**Soil Moisture Conservation and Bunding Initiative:** Soil moisture conservation is a crucial practice that helps reduce the length of slopes, enhance groundwater recharge, and improve crop cultivation. bunding plays a key role in controlling soil erosion and ensuring better water retention for farmers. In **64 village and 311 farmers have developed the farm bund in 351.17 hectares** of farmland is covered. This intervention helps in reducing soil loss, improving water infiltration, and enhancing agricultural productivity. This initiative promotes sustainable farming practices and strengthens the community's resilience to climate variations.

**Continuous Contour Trenches (CCT)** Continuous Contour Trenches (CCT) have been implemented in Tabda, Moskut, Vadhava, and Gopalia villages, covering a total area of 10 hectares. These trenches play a crucial role in preventing downstream flooding, improving soil moisture retention, and effectively managing surface water flow. This intervention contributes to soil conservation, enhances groundwater recharge, and supports sustainable agriculture in the region.

**Common Area Plantation:** A total of 44 villages have successfully completed plantation drives in common areas. The initiative saw active involvement of the community, with strong support from Gram Panchayats through MNREGA, which provided labor support for plantation activities. These efforts also aimed to sensitize communities about the importance of trees for the environment and human wellbeing. Various species such as bamboo, neem, eucalyptus (nilgiri), mango, guava, and moringa were planted to promote ecological balance and local biodiversity. Total saplings planted: 1 lakh Total area covered: 48.9 hectares

**Drinking Water Work:-** Pipeline and water tank construction work has been completed in 30 villages. As part of the initiative, INRECA conducted village-level mapping to identify existing gaps in the drinking water infrastructure. The assessment revealed some critical issues:



**Climate Adaptive farming:** . Soil Sample Collection and Analysis:- Soil samples were collected from 71 villages, covering 1,117 farmers. The primary objective of this initiative was to: 1. Educate farmers on proper soil sampling techniques to ensure accurate results. 2. Help farmers understand their land's nutrient availability and adopt appropriate soil management practices. 3. The collected soil samples were sent to IFFCO Gandhinagar, our collaborating agency, for testing. The analysis was conducted free of cost, providing valuable insights to farmers on improving soil health and optimizing fertilizer use. This initiative supports sustainable agriculture by promoting scientific soil management and encouraging the use of balanced nutrients.

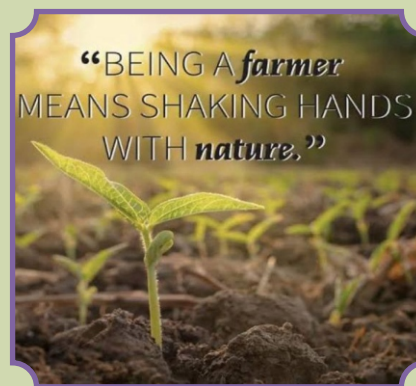

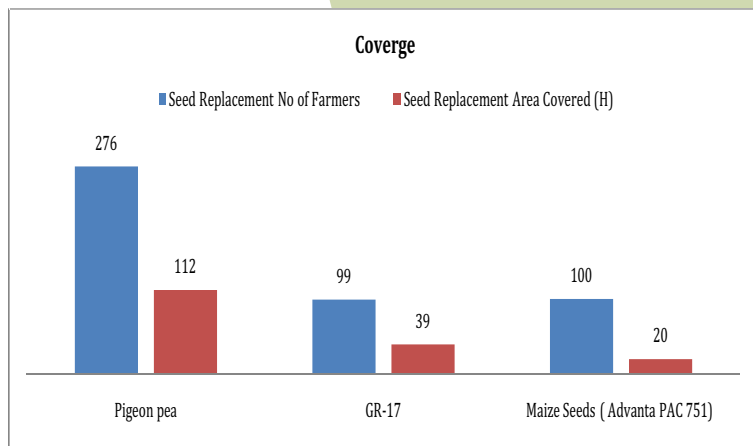

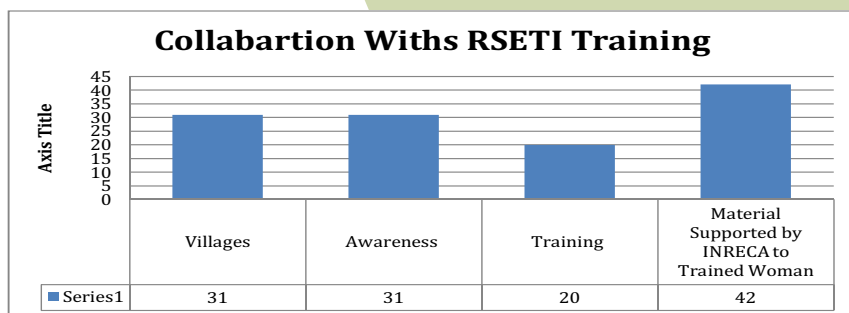
## Diversifying rural income for woman Entrepreneurship:- ( DRIWE)

**Goat rearing training:** Goat is importance livelihood in rural area, communities livelihood dependent on goat rearing, so our objective is the improvement existing livelihood and enhancing the income. 3 program have conducted Sagbara block Navifali village, Garudeswar block Samsherpura village and Nandod block Chhatvada village, Sh Amitkumar, Goat Livestock expert are given to training of the goat entrepreneur. The issue of the bargaining with local vendor and goat rearer, so beneficiaries can selling they goat through weighing. Management of Goat fodder: We new initiative started supported goat rear to Gliricidia fodder. Gliricidia sepium is used as cut and carry forage for cattle, sheep, and goats. Its high protein content allows it to complement low-quality tropical forages. G. sepium can tolerate repeated cutting, every 2 to 4 months depending on the climate.

This Dairy started through 60 beneficiaries are benefiting.

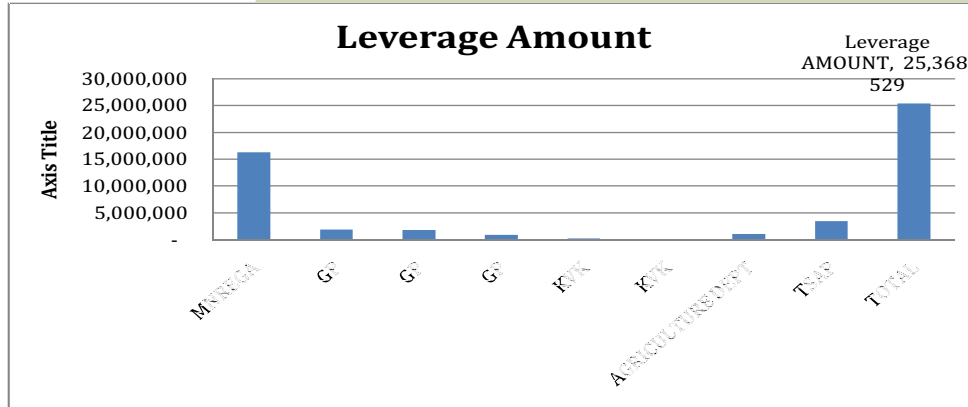

# Millet Mission Programme (Maize Cultivation)

INRECA Sansthan has long association with National Seeds Corporation (NSC), New Delhi an autonomous body under the Central Ministry. Dr. A.K Singh Ex-AGM of NSC Known to us as we were working together since 1990 onwards & distributing Certified and Verified Seeds to the tribal farmers through our an Agricultural Cooperative & used to benefiting them in large extent. Now Shree Narendra Modi; the beloved revered & honorable Prime Minister of India has established a Millet Mission of India where local & traditional staple Millet varieties like moria, koda, bunti, ragi, makai, jwar, bajri etc. cultivation. Dr. A.K Singh along with Dr. Sain Das Ex. Director, Indian Council for Agriculture Research (ICAR) New Delhi who is currently member of Advisory committee of Millet Mission Government of India Contacted us & visited our organization for the Cultivation & promotion of Maize crop with specialized seeds where in soil texture of our area is very much appropriate & conducive for maize cultivation. So, we have shown interest as we are already working on livelihood Program with the motive of doubling the income through Agricultural producers of tribal Farmers which were fulfilling the local aspirations & our objectives too.

Dr. Sain Dass & Dr. A.K Singh Visited our field area along with our field Staff. They found that Soil Texture, its moisture retention capacity is quite appropriate & decided to initiate Customized Maize Cultivation especially Pop-corn. it is very popular & demanding in western countries. On the other hand, farmer would get very lucrative prices of their produces however before the lunch the program we found their the season was almost went out & majoring of the area was already sown by the farmers & a very few farmers were to left out to for sowing of their land. Apart from it, there were various issues which were very much crucial & need clarifications like:-

1. Supplying of specialized/Customized Certified Maize seed.
2. Developing value Chain system for purchasing of produces of farmers.
3. Other technical aspects & awareness issues



Eventually, we have come to the conclusion on following points.

Being First attempt, this project shall be considered a pilot project for our area & local tribal farmers. Certified, customized Seed shall be supplied though INRECA Sansthan free of cost @5 kg/acre worth of Rs 15000/-

Moisture retention in area is optimum. However irrigation facilities are required so Consent is required from farmers to get ready for irrigation if required.

No inorganic fertilizer is required however may be used if required.

No. insecticide is required despite may be used if local area is infected of any such diseases or bacteria.

Emphasis shall be given on organic farming however this relaxation has been given being a pilot project in our area.

Buying back policy shall be adopted.

Transportation facilities shall be provided by the company who ever would supplying Seeds & ready to purchase the produces..

# Millet Mission Programme (Maize Cultivation)

Rates were also fixed before distributing of seeds as Rs 30/kg as to garner the confidence of local farmers being interacting first time in this regard. The entire cone including kernel shall be weighted & payment would done for entire cone in order to maintain the moisture till the Corn is reached to the destination for further processing. And like wise we worked out in order accordance with the frame work mutually decided.

Eventually, Thai pilot project has been very much Successful. All tribal formers are very happy as they got more than double prices of their produces & payments were directly deposited in 2 installments: First installment immediately after weighing of staple & 2nd as the material reaches to the processing Centre.

## These are the outcomes of the projects are:-During 2023-24

Total 650 tribal farmers were given seeds out of selected 630 Almost 50 acres of Crop failed due to negligence, poor water availability & partly sowing etc. as some Farmers were not having faith on the new variety of Seeds supplied to them.

Areas like Khokharaumar Khopi, Sorapada, Panchpipri, Pana, Parodi, Umaran, Javali, villages have good potential.

18 Farmers yielded more than 2 tons / acre & 4 Farmers 2.5 tons/per acres which is encouraging. & rest of them yielded 1.00 ton/per acres

Finally, we conclude that there is a lot of potential for maize cultivation in Narmada valley. We have decided to ahead for covering larger area in ensuing period. during this year about 500 tons maize has been grown

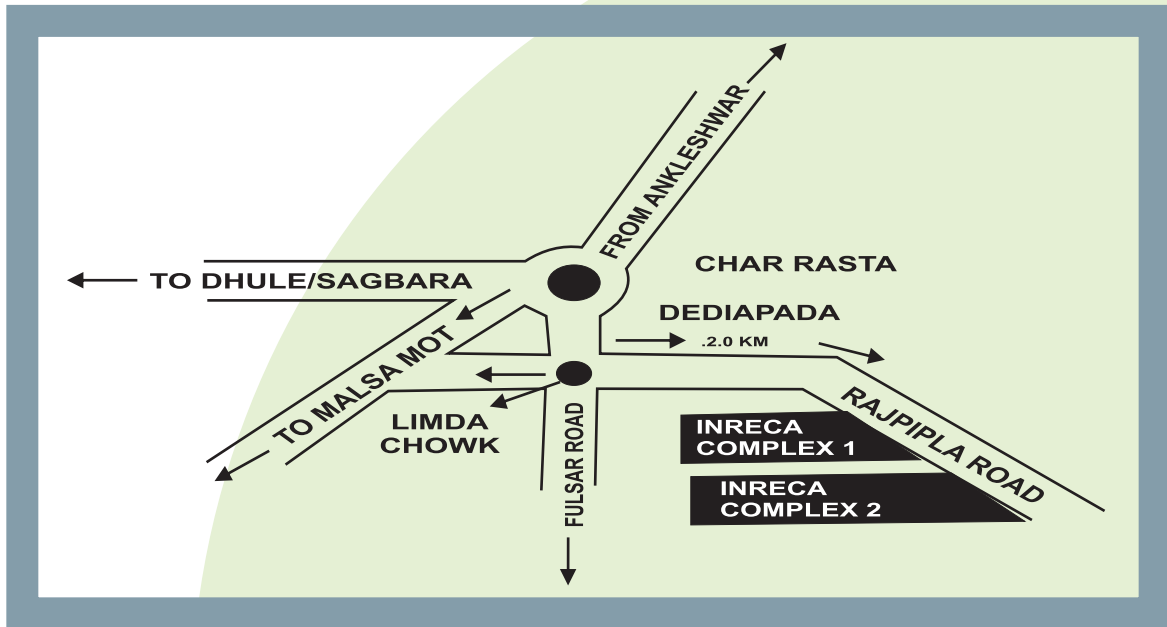
